

# Regulatory guidelines for sunscreen and self tan products

This guide outlines the additional mandatory artwork requirements for sunscreen and self tan products. These requirements are in addition to the general labelling obligations that apply to all cosmetic products. Use this document as a guide to ensure your artwork design fully complies with relevant regulations.

In the **Elements** column, you'll find the additional mandatory labelling requirements specifically for sunscreen products, along with precautionary statements, instructions for use, and storage information relevant to sunscreen and / or self-tan products. In the **Explanation** and **Examples & symbols** column, we clarify what each element entails and why or when it is required.

If your product is an aerosol, wet wipe, and / or sold in the UK, you will receive a separate PDF detailing the specific requirements for those categories. You will also be provided with a general guide covering the mandatory requirements for all cosmetic products.

### Mandatory elements for sunscreen products (not self tan)

Elements	Explanation	Examples & symbols
1. Forbidden claims	Claims that implies the following characteristics are strictly forbidden:  • 100 % protection from UV radiation  • No need to re-apply the product under any circumstances	<ul><li> "Sunblock"</li><li> "Sunblocker"</li><li> "Full or total protection"</li></ul>
2. UVA labelling	UVA protection must be indicated on the label using one or both of the following methods:  1. The UVA symbol/logotype (recommended by trade organizations)  2. The term "UVA-protection"	The UVA symbol:
3. UVB labelling - Sun Protection Factor (SPF)	UVB protection must be clearly stated on the label using the appropriate SPF category. This allows consumers to understand the level of sun protection the product offers.  The SPF labelling must be stated with text (Labelled cateogory) and number (Labelled SPF). #### **Precautions and instructions for use for sunscreen products**

All precautions and informations for use must be provided in the official language(s) of the country where the product is being sold. English is only accepted in Cyprus, Ireland, Malta, and the UK. Below, you'll find legally approved wording in both English and Swedish that you can use on your product packaging.

4. Precautions	"Do not stay too long in the sun, even while using a sunscreen product. Keep babies and young children out of direct sunlight. Over-exposure to the sun is a serious health threat. Reducing the quantity of sunscreen product applied will lower the level of protection significantly."	"Vistas inte för länge i solen, även om du använder ett solskyddsmedel. ### Storage information and precautions for self tan products

All storage information and precautions must be provided in the official language(s) of the country where the product is being sold. English is only accepted in Cyprus, Ireland, Malta, and the UK. Below, you'll find legally approved wording in both English and Swedish that you can use on your product packaging.

1. Storage information	"Store in dark place at room temperature."	"Förvaras mörkt i rumstemperatur."
2. Precautions	"Use only on intact skin. Avoid contact with eyes."	"Använd endast på intakt hud. Undvik kontakt med ögonen."
